PRODUCTS AFFECTED

Garmin GPS III Pilot products are affected.

ISSUE

Due to storage capacity limitations, Navigation Database cycle 1801 (effective dates 1/4/18 – 2/1/18) will be the last GPS III Pilot supported Navigation Database.

ACTION

For product replacement considerations, the aera[®] 660 is a new cost-effective, feature-rich, purpose-built aviation portable.
