TO: Users of all Garmin aviation products and Garmin Pilot using the US or North America FliteCharts database

SUBJECT: Corrected charts for RNAV (GPS) RWY 24, Amdt 2E at Martha's Vineyard (MVY), Vineyard Haven, MA

DESCRIPTION

The FAA has advised Garmin that the island of Martha's Vineyard is missing on the RNAV (GPS) RWY 24 chart at Martha's Vineyard (KMOVY), Vineyard Haven, MA in the Terminal Procedure Publication, NE-1 volume, and the digital-Terminal Procedures Publication, effective March 1, 2018 and March 29, 2018.

PILOT ACTION

Exercise caution when using the RNAV (GPS) RWY 24 chart at Martha's Vineyard (KMOVY), Vineyard Haven, MA with cycle 1803 or 1804 US or North America FliteCharts.

RESOLUTION

The corrected chart will be included in the 1805 cycle of the US and North America FliteCharts databases for applicable Garmin aviation products and in Garmin Pilot.

Garmin requests that the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information.
