SUBJECT: Missing Step-Down Fix

DESCRIPTION

Garmin has been made aware that the following procedure was delivered with a missing step-down fix and altitude:

Airport	Procedure	Error
KRLD	VOR/DME-A (VDMA)	STAID fix (PSC 11.7 DME) should be located between CHAZZ (FAF) and MACUF (MAP) with a minimum altitude of 1,540ft.

This alert applies to the 1810 & 1811 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database. This Data Alert does not apply to the Jeppesen NavData database.

PILOT ACTION

Do not use the procedure in any manner.

RESOLUTION

The procedure will be corrected in the 1812 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database.

THIS ALERT SHOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL USERS OF GARMIN AVIATION UNITS OR SYSTEMS UTILIZING THE GARMIN NAVIGATION DATABASE

Garmin requests that the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information. These discrepancies could come in the form of an incorrect procedure, incorrectly identified terrain, obstacles, fixes, or any other displayed item used for navigation or communication in the air or on the ground.
