### **DESCRIPTION**

Garmin has been made aware that the following procedures were delivered with erroneous data defining the final approach portion of the following procedures:

<b>Airport</b>	<b>Procedure</b>	<b>Error</b>
CTP9	RNAV (GNSS) RWY 11 (R11)	The LPV was delivered with erroneous data defining the final approach portion for the procedure.

This alert applies to the 1812 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database. This Data Alert does not apply to the Jeppesen NavData database.

### **PILOT ACTION**

Do not use this procedure in cycle 1812.

### **RESOLUTION**

The procedure will be corrected in the 1813 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database.
