Incorrect Departure Identifier

Jeppesen NavData for cycles 1904 and 1905, effective 28 Mar 2019 and 25 April 2019 respectively, contains incorrect Departure identifier. Class One Notam K1009/18 changed the identifier from FIG 2A to FIG 2B. Class One Notam K1009/18 has been cancelled.

## THEREFORE, DEPARTURE FIG 2B IDENTIFIER HAS CHANGED BACK TO FIG 2A.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1906, effective 23 May 2019. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<u>http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/alerts.jsp</u>).
