TO: Users of all Garmin aviation products and Garmin Pilot using the US or North America FliteCharts database

SUBJECT: ERNNY SIX ARRIVAL (RNAV) Transition Routes and MADII FIVE ARRIVAL (RNAV) Transition Routes at Chicago O'Hare INTL, Chicago, IL (ORD)

DESCRIPTION

The FAA has advised Garmin that the digital-Terminal Procedures Publication, effective May 21, 2020, shows incorrect depictions of the FOLGO Transition, (FOLGO.ERNNY6) and (FOLGO.MADII5), on the ERNNY SIX ARRIVAL (RNAV) and MADII FIVE ARRIVAL (RNAV) charts respectively at Chicago O'Hare Intl, (KORD), Chicago, Illinois.

PILOT ACTION

Exercise extreme caution when referencing the ERNNY SIX ARRIVAL (RNAV) and MADII FIVE ARRIVAL (RNAV) charts at Chicago O'Hare Intl, (KORD), Chicago, Illinois in US or North America FliteCharts.

RESOLUTION

The charts will be corrected in the 2007 cycle, effective June 18, 2020, of the US and North America FliteCharts databases for applicable Garmin aviation products and in Garmin Pilot.

FAA Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.

THIS ALERT SHOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL USERS OF GARMIN AVIATION UNITS OR SYSTEMS UTILIZING THE US OR NORTH AMERICA FLITECHARTS DATABASE

Garmin requests that the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information. These discrepancies could come in the form of an incorrect procedure, incorrectly identified terrain, obstacles, fixes, or any other displayed item used for navigation or communication in the air or on the ground.
