SUBJECT: Green Bay Sectional Effective February 25, 2021 – Class G Airspace

DESCRIPTION

The FAA has advised Garmin that the Green Bay Sectional effective February 25, 2021 depicts the Class G airspace incorrectly.

PILOT ACTION

Exercise caution when referencing the US IFR/VFR Charts database near Marquette, MI.

RESOLUTION

Updates to the FAA charts are scheduled for April 22, 2021. Updated charts will be included in cycle 2104 of the US IFR/VFR Charts database for applicable Garmin aviation products and in Garmin Pilot.
