SUBJECT: Incorrect FAF altitude on localizer procedure

DESCRIPTION

Garmin has been made aware that the following localizer procedure was delivered with an incorrect altitude at the Final Approach Fix.:

Airport	Procedure	Error
SKCC	LOC Z RWY 16	The altitude at the FAF 6.0 DME CUC should be At or Above 2900 ft.

This Data Alert applies to the 2505 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database. This Data Alert does not apply to the Jeppesen NavData database.

PILOT ACTION

Use the procedure with extreme caution

RESOLUTION

The procedure will be corrected in the 2506 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database.
