SUBJECT: PEARCE AERODROME (YPEA) NEW DEPARTURE AND APPROACH PROCEDURES

DESCRIPTION

Airservices Australia has advised Garmin that some charts at Pearce Aerodrome (YPEA), Western Australia, Australia included in FliteCharts cycle 2507, effective July 10, 2025, do not depict amendments to circling and alternate minima. Revised charts have been published in SUP H124/25, effective July 10, 2025.

The following charts are affected:

- ILS-X OR LOC-X RWY 36R
- ILS-W OR LOC-W RWY 36R
- RNP RWY 05
- RNP Z RWY 18L
- RNP RWY 23
- RNP Z RWY 36R

PILOT ACTION

Exercise caution when referencing the above charts associated with Pearce Aerodrome (YPEA), Western Australia, Australia in Australia or South Pacific FliteCharts for cycle 2507.

Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.

RESOLUTION

The charts will be corrected in cycle 2508 of the Australia and South Pacific FliteCharts databases for applicable Garmin aviation products and in Garmin Pilot. Cycle 2508 FliteCharts databases are effective August 7, 2025 and will be available August 5, 2025.
