SUBJECT: Stinger MOA Missing on FAA IFR Low Enroute L-27 Chart

DESCRIPTION

The FAA has advised Garmin that the southern half of the Stinger MOA that is normally depicted on the FAA IFR Low Enroute L-27 chart, effective June 12, 2025, is missing. This omission is reflected in the United States IFR/VFR Charts database used in all Garmin aviation products, including Garmin Pilot, for cycles 2506 and 2507. The following corrected depiction, which will be released by the FAA in the L-27 chart effective August 7, 2025, will be included in the IFR/VFR Charts database in cycle 2508.

PILOT ACTION

Consult FAA NOTAM 5/5030 and exercise caution when referencing IFR/VFR Charts for cycles 2506 and 2507 while operating in the vicinity of the Stinger MOA.

Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.

RESOLUTION

The corrected FAA IFR Low Enroute L-27 chart will be included in cycle 2508 of the United States IFR/VFR Charts database. Cycle 2508 IFR/VFR Charts databases are effective August 7, 2025 and will be available August 6, 2025.

THIS ALERT SHOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL USERS OF GARMIN AVIATION UNITS OR SYSTEMS UTILIZING AN APPLICABLE IFR/VFR CHARTS DATABASE

Garmin requests that the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information. These discrepancies could come in the form of an incorrect procedure, incorrectly identified terrain, obstacles, fixes, or any other displayed item used for navigation or communication in the air or on the ground.
