SUBJECT: CAIRNS AERODROME (YBCS) DAP STAR CHARTS

DESCRIPTION

Airservices Australia has advised Garmin that some charts at CAIRNS (YBCS), Queensland, Australia included in FliteCharts cycle 2508, effective August 07, 2025, do not depict amendments and additions to standard instrument arrival procedures. Revised charts have been published in SUP H46/25, effective April 17, 2025.

The following charts are missing:

- STAR CODIE ONE ALPHA X-RAY ZULU ARRIVALS (RNAV)
- STAR HENDO TWO ALPHA YANKEE ARRIVALS (RNAV)
- STAR UPOLO TWO ALPHA BRAVO ZULU ARRIVALS (RNAV)
- STAR UPOLO TWO VICTOR ARRIVAL (RNAV)
- STAR UPOLO TWO X-RAY ARRIVAL (RNAV)

PILOT ACTION

Exercise caution when referencing the above charts associated with CAIRNS (YBCS), Queensland, Australia in Australia or South Pacific FliteCharts for cycle 2508.

Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.

RESOLUTION

The charts will be corrected in cycle 2509 of the Australia and South Pacific FliteCharts databases for applicable Garmin aviation products and in Garmin Pilot. Cycle 2509 FliteCharts databases are effective September 4, 2025 and will be available September 2, 2025.

THIS ALERT SHOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL USERS OF GARMIN AVIATION UNITS OR SYSTEMS USING THE AUSTRALIA OR SOUTH PACIFIC FLITECHARTS DATABASE

Garmin requests that the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information.
