SUBJECT: Incorrect Altitude on Missed Approach

PRODUCT AFFECTED

The Garmin Navigation Database cycles 2509 (effective September 04, 2025) and 2510 (effective October 2, 2025) are affected.



NOTE

The data alert does not apply to the Jeppesen NavData database.

DESCRIPTION

The ILS/DME or LOC/DME RWY 26 procedure at NCRG (Rarotonga International Airport Avarua, Cook Islands) has an incorrect final altitude on the missed approach.

The correct mandatory altitude at RG VOR/DME on the missed approach is AT 3300 ft.

PILOT ACTION

Use caution when flying the missed approach in cycles 2509 and 2510.

RESOLUTION

The procedure will be corrected in the 2511 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database, effective October 30, 2025 and will be available October 23, 2025.

Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.

Garmin requests the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information. These discrepancies could come in the form of an incorrect procedure, incorrectly identified terrain, obstacles, fixes, or any other displayed item used for navigation or communication in the air or on the ground.
