SUBJECT: Duplicate Block Altitude and Missing Speed Restriction on KSMO ZUUMA 4 ARR (RNAV)

PRODUCT AFFECTED

The Garmin SmartCharts procedure for the ZUUMA 4 ARR (RNAV) at KSMO, Santa Monica, CA, shown in Garmin Pilot Mobile iOS is affected.

DESCRIPTION

When the procedure is filtered to show only the ZUUMA transition, the speed constraint on planview at fix ZUUMA is missing. The correct speed constraint is AT 250KT.

When the procedure is filtered to the ALL, BURGL, DOUIT, or REBRG transitions, a duplicate Block Altitude of ATBEL 11000' & ATABV 9000' appears on the planview at fix ZUUMA.

PILOT ACTION

Use caution when filtering the procedure to show only the ZUUMA transition. Viewing ALL, BURGL, DOUIT, or REBRG transitions will show the correct speed constraint at fix ZUUMA.

Ignore duplicate Block Altitude for the ALL, BURGL, DOUIT, or REBRG transitions.

RESOLUTION

This SmartCharts procedure will be corrected in cycle 2602.

Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.
