SUBJECT: MELBOURNE AERODROME (YMML) TAXIWAY ALPHA RECOMMISSIONING

DESCRIPTION

Airservices Australia has advised Garmin that some charts at Melbourne Airport (YMML) Victoria, Australia included in FliteCharts cycle 2604, effective April 16, 2026, do not depict amendments to aerodrome ground movement charts. Revised charts have been published in SUP H48/26, effective April 02, 2026.

The following charts are affected:

PILOT ACTION

Exercise caution when referencing the above charts associated with Melbourne Airport (YMML), Victoria, Australia in Australia or South Pacific FliteCharts for cycle 2604.

Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.

RESOLUTION

The charts will be corrected in cycle 2605 of the Australia and South Pacific FliteCharts databases for applicable Garmin aviation products and in Garmin Pilot. Cycle 2605 FliteCharts databases are effective May 14, 2026 and will be available May 12, 2026.

Garmin requests that the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information. These discrepancies could come in the form of an incorrect procedure, incorrectly identified terrain, obstacles, fixes, or any other displayed item used for navigation or communication in the air or on the ground.
