PRODUCT AFFECTED

The Garmin SmartCharts procedures for the RIICE 1 ARRIVAL at the airports listed below shown in Garmin Pilot Mobile iOS are affected:

- KCXO, Houston, Texas
- 6R3, Cleveland, Texas
- KDWH, Houston, Texas
- T78, Liberty, Texas

DESCRIPTION

When viewing any selectable transition or runway combination for the procedure, the MEA of 2100 from RIICE to BRKMN is missing on the graphical chart depiction.

PILOT ACTION

Use caution not to descend below the MEA of 2100 from RIICE to BRKMN.

RESOLUTION

This will be corrected in cycle 2606.
