PRODUCT AFFECTED

Cycle 2607 and 2608 of the Garmin Navigation Database (effective 09 JUL 2026 to 03 SEP 2026) is affected.

DESCRIPTION

The following departure has an incorrect altitude.

Airport	Procedure	Correction
CAL4	RNAV (GNSS) RWY 13	The correct minimum altitude for LENAV and IKDUD is At or Above 3400 ft.

PILOT ACTION

Use the procedure with caution.

RESOLUTION

The procedure will be corrected in the 2609 cycle of the Garmin Navigation Database.
