SUBJECT: TAKEOFF MINIMUMS out-of-date in NC-3 Takeoff Minimums

DESCRIPTION

The FAA has advised Garmin that the digital-Terminal Procedures Publication, effective July 9, 2026, contains out-of-date TAKEOFF MINIMUMS charts at:

- Maquoketa MUNI (OQW), Maquoketa, IA
- Ottumwa RGNL (OTM), Ottumwa, IA
- Waverly MUNI (C25), Waverly, IA
- Winterset MUNI (3Y3), Winterset, IA

PILOT ACTION

Exercise caution when using the TAKEOFF MINIMUMS charts at the above airports in FliteCharts for cycle 2607.

Alerts are written for the currently effective cycle and next cycle. It is possible that data from prior cycles is also affected. Garmin recommends using the latest effective data cycle.

RESOLUTION

The charts will be corrected in cycle 2608 of the FliteCharts databases for applicable Garmin aviation products and in Garmin Pilot. Cycle 2608 FliteCharts databases are effective August 6, 2026, and will be available August 4, 2026.

Garmin requests that the flight crew report any observed discrepancies related to database information. These discrepancies could come in the form of an incorrect procedure, incorrectly identified terrain, obstacles, fixes, or any other displayed item used for navigation or communication in the air or on the ground.
