PRODUCT AFFECTED

Cycle 2607 of the Garmin Navigation Database (effective 09 JUL 2026 to 06 AUG 2026) is affected.

This Data Alert does not apply to the Jeppesen NavData database.

DESCRIPTION

The following procedures are missing speed and altitude restrictions due to late source.
