SUBJECT: Incorrect minima visibility values

PRODUCT AFFECTED

The Garmin SmartCharts procedures shown below in Garmin Pilot Mobile iOS and Garmin Pilot Web are affected:

- RNAV (GPS) Z RWY 14 at PASD, Sand Point, AK, USA
- RNAV (GPS) RWY 31 at KDBQ, Dubuque, IA, USA

DESCRIPTION

- RNAV (GPS) Z RWY 14 at PASD
 - For CIRCLING visibility CAT A an incorrect visibility is shown, the correct visibility is 1 ¼ SM.
- RNAV (GPS) RWY 31 at KDBQ
 - For LNAV visibility CAT C an incorrect visibility is shown, the correct visibility is 1 SM.

PILOT ACTION

Use these SmartCharts procedures with caution and use the correct visibility values listed above for the given lines of minimums and categories.

RESOLUTION

These SmartCharts procedures will be corrected in cycle 2610.
